I am writing regarding the consideration of leasing new parcels of Wayne National Forestland for oil and gas exploration. Because the drilling technologies used in hydraulic fracturing are relatively new and were not contemplated at the time the Wayne National Forest adopted rules in 2006 or included in the plan, it would seem that an Environmental Impact Study would be helpful.

Hydraulic fracturing could potentially have environmental, economical, safety and public health effects on Wayne National Forest and the surrounding communities. Due to this significant impact on our region, it is important to approach this issue with a clear understanding of all possible outcomes.

According to the U.S. Forest Service groundwater policy and guidance documents, the Wayne National Forest has the responsibility to protect groundwater and drinking water supplies that may be affected by its activities. I ask that you carefully consider the impacts of these activities through an Environmental Impact Study.
